- Praise your child for their effort and progress.

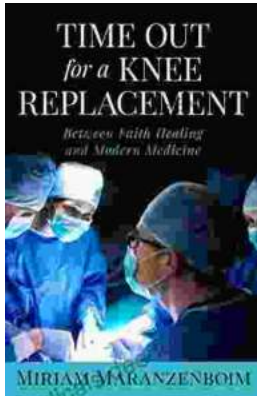
